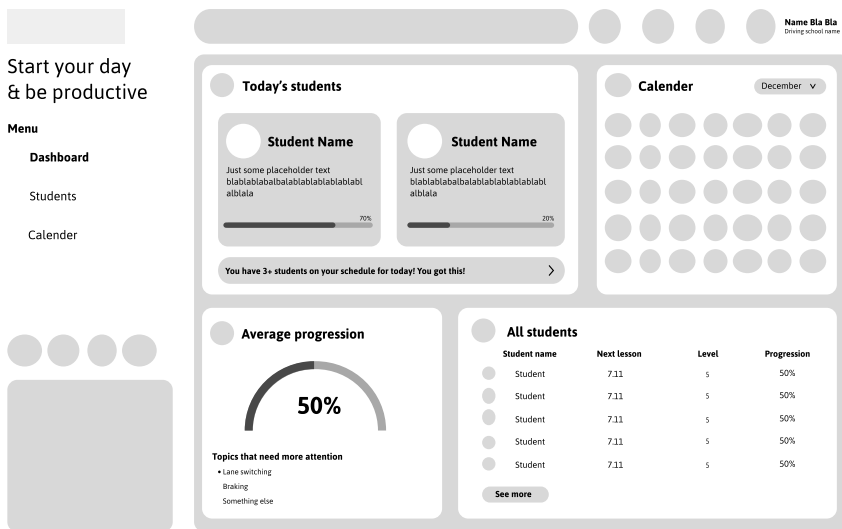
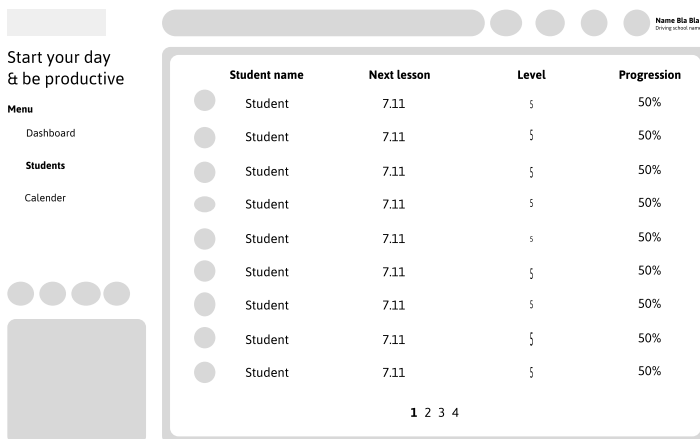

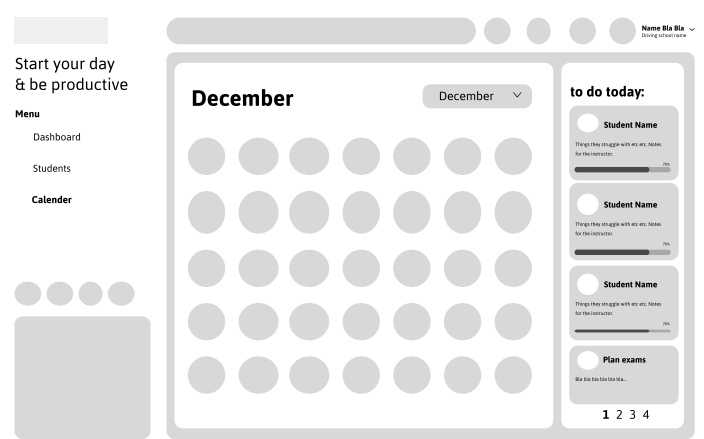


1st version of wireframe

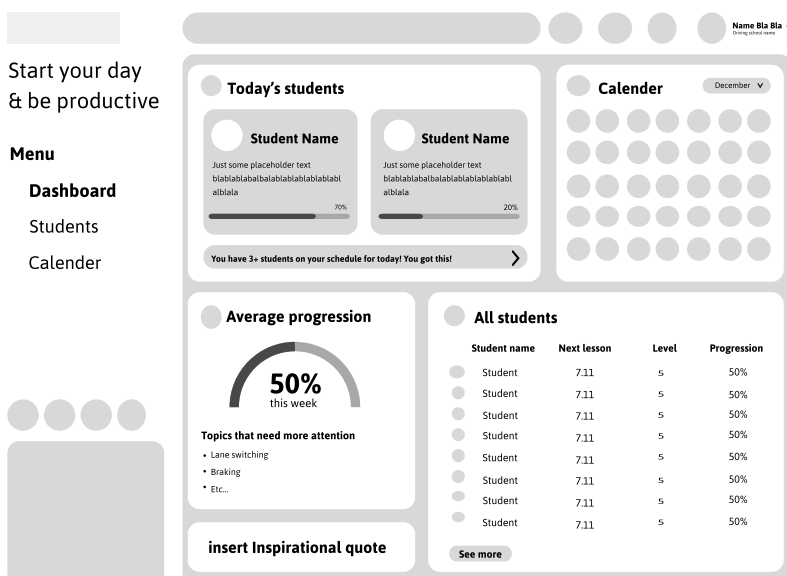

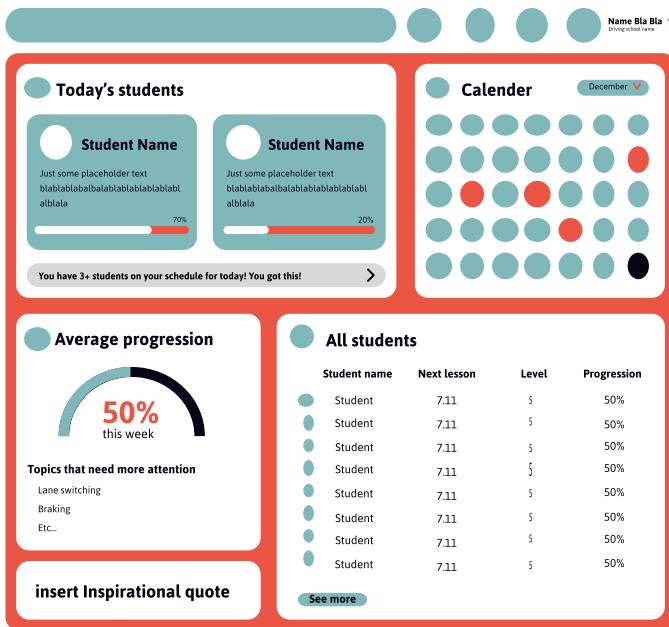

I added in the logo that my team mates created and used the colours that we decided on using.

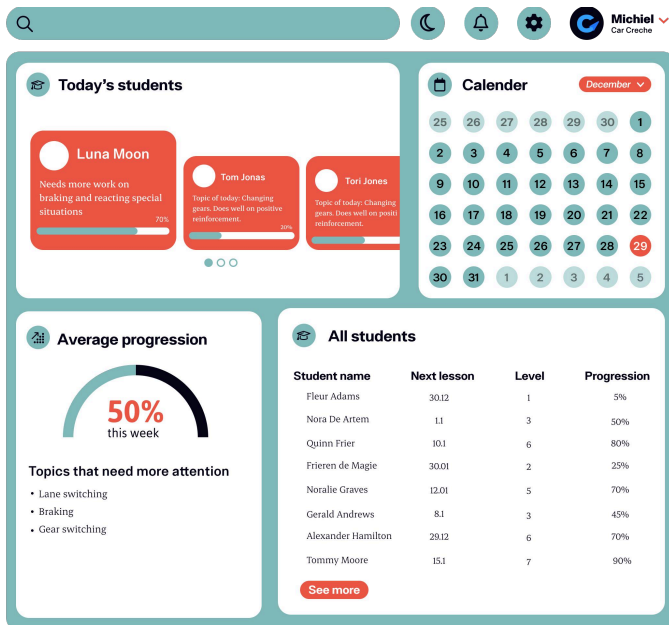

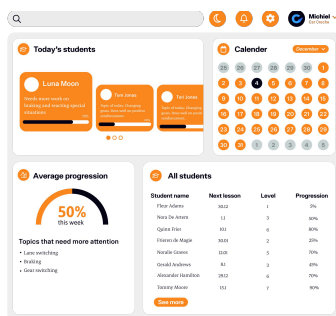

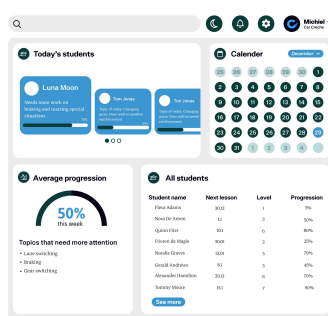

We soon realised that the colours we picked didn't work as well for the app itself. We experimented with different colours together, and eventually settled on the one on the next page.

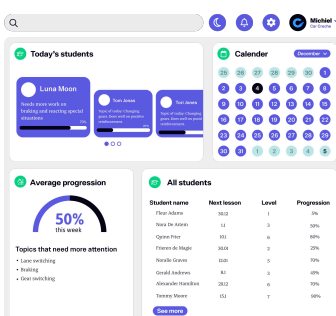

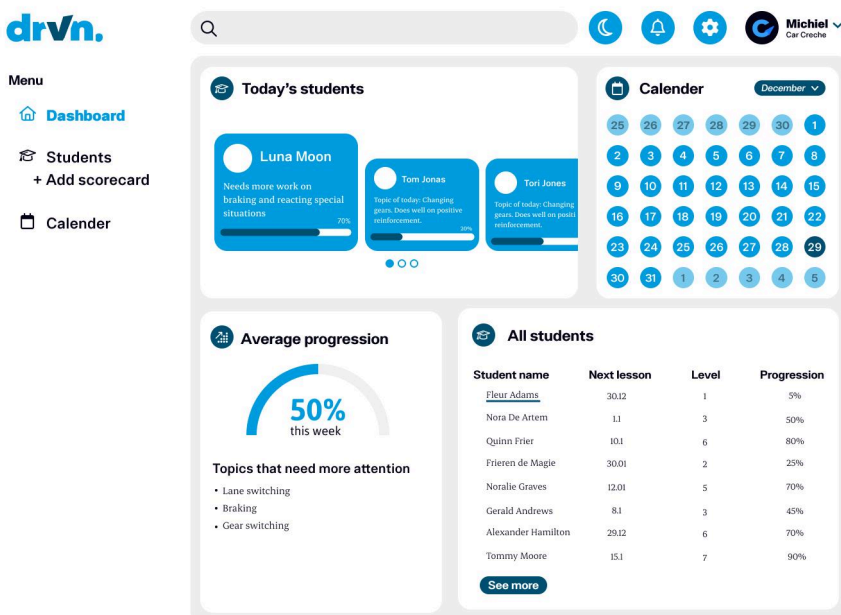
4th version of Lo-Fi prototype
